
























Italian 2021 population pyramid



Three research perspectives

- (1) Micro-level (individuals)
- (2) Meso-level (e.g., households, care providers, volunteering organizations, and firms)
- (3) Macro-level (society, institutions)









Three life course principles

- (1) Cumulative contingencies (previous experiences shape a person's current status)
- (2) Linked lives (events in one domain of a person's life influence all of their other domains)
- (3) Historical time period and Context (the period and the context in which individuals live moderates the timing and sequencing of key life course transitions)









Cast

- A world-class team of **350** experts from different scientific areas
- ~50% female researchers (~40% in leadership positions)
- ~20% of young researchers
- ~300 new researchers hired (RTD-A, post-doc, PhD students)



- Organise an AGE-IT European Stakeholder Seminar in Brussels (e.g. at the European Parliament or in the Permanent Representation of Italy to the EU) in 2025, where the first results of the AGE-IT project are presented and discussed with a selected group of international experts from science, politics, societal organisations and business;
- Summarize the results of the AGE-IT European Stakeholder Seminar into a Discussion Paper;
- Organise an online High-level Policy Expert Meeting in 2024, 2025 and 2026 with a group of selected experts from science, politics, societal organisations and business on policy-relevant topics relevant to the AGE-IT agenda;
- Summarise the results of each of the High-level Policy Expert Meetings into a policy briefing;
- Promote these activities on social media to policy audiences;
